Alphabet Pack: Playdough Activity Pack

REQUIRED MATERIALS:

- Laminator or Page Protectors
- Mini-Clothespins or Paperclips
- Playdough in a variety of colors

What's Included:


This pack includes 52 alphabet task cards (on 14 sheets of paper) and 21 follow-up play dough mats. There is also an ASL Fingerspelling Chart in the appendix.

How to Use:


These task cards are designed to fit perfectly inside standard task card photo containers. (4x6) After laminating the cards, cut them apart and store them inside a task box. There are 52 task cards so they should fill up about half of the box, leaving you room to store mini-clothespins or paperclips. Each task card gives students an example of how to make the letter with dough as well as a beginning letter picture. Students are asked to "clip" the picture with the same beginning letter. Follow up play dough mats include a variety of shapes and pictures for students to build from dough. Slide the pages into a page protector for reuse. ASL fingerspelling of each picture word is provided for students to practice their ASL skills. Older children can be encouraged to "decode" the ASL fingerspelling to write the word on a sheet of paper.
































































