Popsicle Stick Activity Pack

REQUIRED MATERIALS:

- Laminator or Page Protectors
- Colored Popsicle Sticks (or color natural ones with red, yellow, green, blue, purple)
- Natural Popsicle Sticks
- Mini-Popsicle Sticks (or cut a few natural ones in half...watch the edges)

What's Included:

This pack includes 26 alphabet popsicle stick cards, 20 popsicle stick arrays, and 12 popsicle stick pattern cards. Each task card provides students the opportunity to recreate the letter, picture, or pattern. Eleven popsicle stick picture worksheets are provided for extra fun. Additionally, one universal follow-up worksheet is provided for extended pattern work.

How to Use:

These task cards are designed to fit perfectly inside standard task card photo containers. (4x6) After laminating the cards, cut them apart and store them inside a task box. There are 58 task cards so they should fill up about 1/2 of the box, leaving you room to store the popsicle sticks on top. Each task card provides students the opportunity to recreate the letter, picture, or pattern. Students recreate the picture using the popsicle sticks. Use the follow-up worksheet to expand learning.
