## Needs:

Students will need a set of colored pencils or crayons, glue, and scissors.

## How to Use:

We recommend using our ABC Bible Review pages on a weekly basis. These alphabet review pages for kids are great for Sunday School, VBS, Children's Church, morning-work stations, early finisher activities, and take-home activities. Students will have ample opportunity to write and trace upper and lower case letters, color each Bible-themed image, and complete a challenging maze. Starting at an open entrance, students will use their writing utensil to follow the path under, over, and through as they make their way to the end. Teach students to look ahead for openings before marking path. After solving the mazes, encourage students should read aloud the sentences: "A is for Adam" then "A sounds like a-a-adam". As an added benefit, ask students to sound out the letter sound as they write; "A says aaaaa, B says buh".

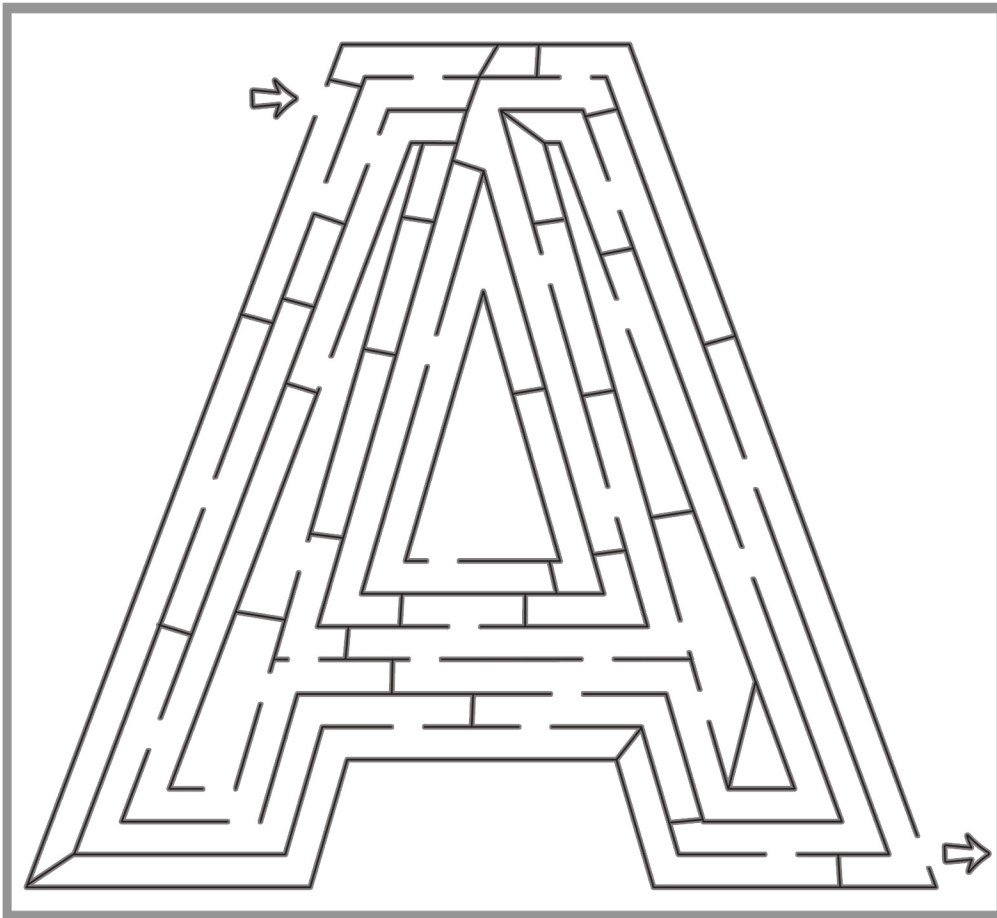

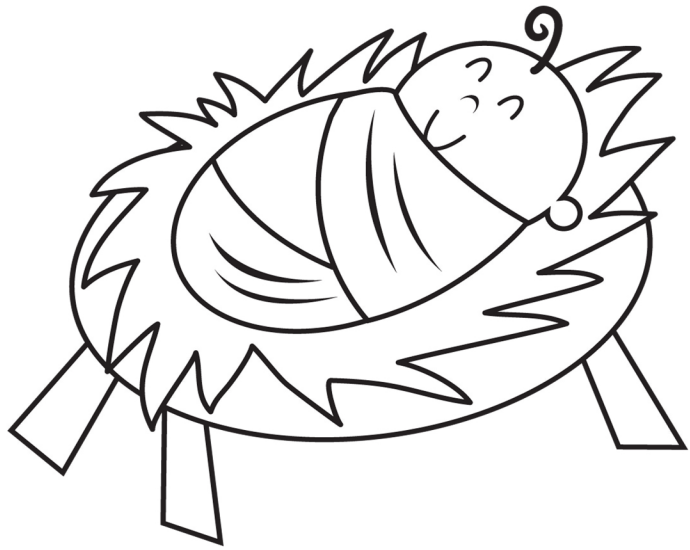

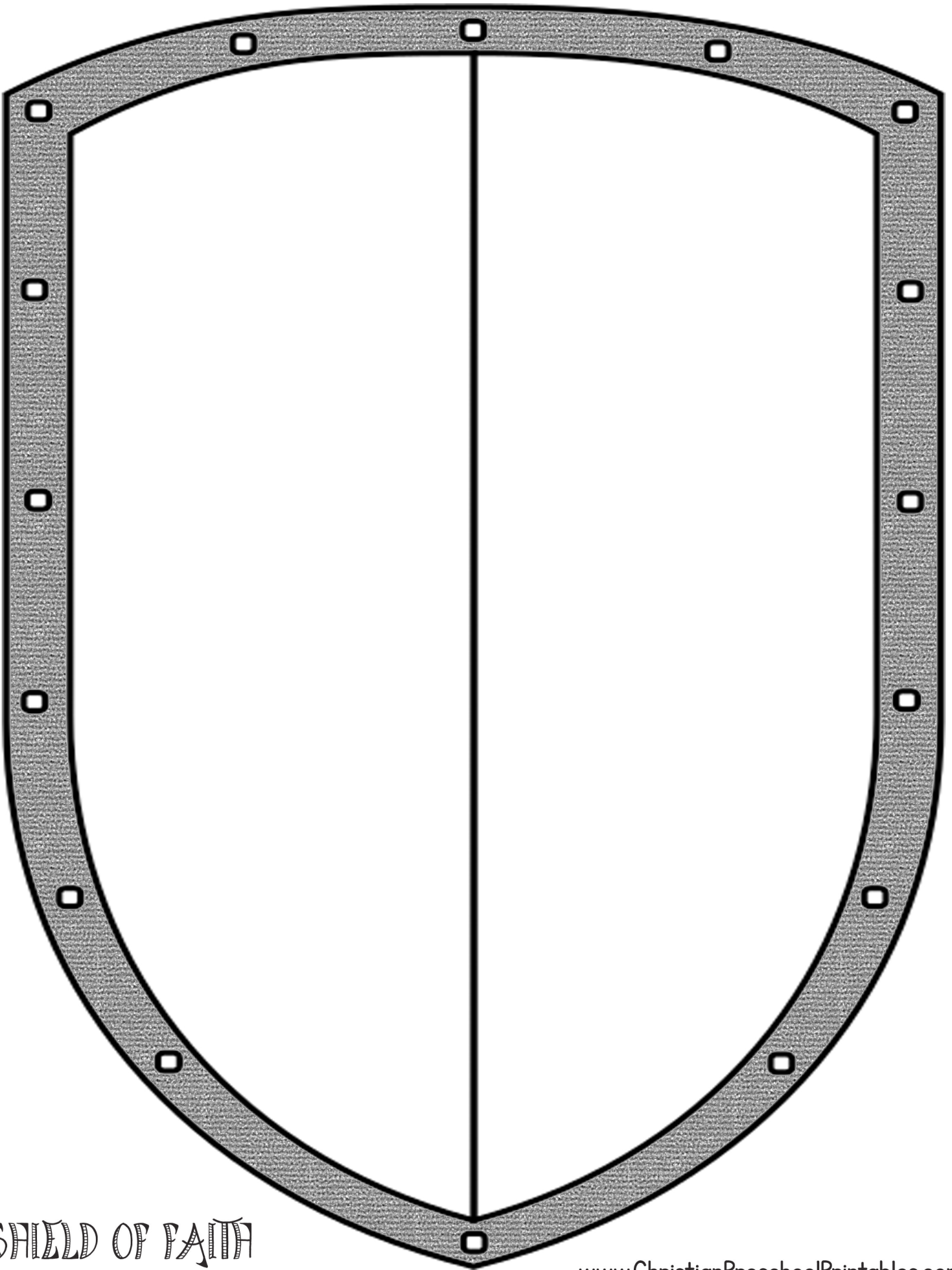


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## Shield of Faith Gemstones

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1. Print shield onto carstock and laminate or glue to cardboard if possible.
2. Print gemstones onto sticker paper if you have it, if not copy paper and a glue stick work just as well.
3. Each week as your child completes their lessons and says their Bible verse, let them choose a gemstone to add to their shield.
