

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
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First-Grade Writing Prompts November Pack

REQUIRED MATERIALS:

- Printed worksheet
- Pencil
- Scissors (for the Animal Research Fact Flipper and Layer Book)
- Stapler (for the Animal Research Fact Flipper and Layer Book)
- One dice per small group of students (for the Roll-A-Story)

What's Included:

This pack includes 20 engaging writing worksheets (approximately one for each school day of the month) intended as daily writing exercises. These sheets are a fun way to teach opinion, informative, narrative, and creative writing to students, taking them through the steps of writing, including pre-writing, writing, revising, editing, and publishing.

How to Use:

Following the November calendar on the next page, review the daily worksheet with students. All of the worksheets are self-explanatory, but it's helpful to make sure the students understand what is expected. Do this for each school day, Monday through Thursday. On Fridays, allow students to choose their favorite writing prompt of the week to revise, edit, and publish on the final draft worksheet provided.

NOTE: The Animal Research Fact Flipper and the Animal Research Layer Book are designed to be cut out, stacked, and stapled.


